

## Important Update Google Reviews for Schools Being Removed

You may have seen the announcement that Google recently removed school reviews and ratings. This affects all general education schools worldwide (primary, elementary, middle, and high schools) to reduce unhelpful or prank reviews.

#### What's changed:

- Existing reviews are still visible.
- New reviews and ratings can no longer be added.

#### What to do:

- Review current Google reviews: They may be removed in the future. If you recognise reviewers (e.g., parents), consider asking permission to use their comments in school marketing materials or website as testimonials.
- Explore other platforms: Do you know any other popular or trusted review platforms families use (besides School Recommendations on Facebook)? Let us know!
